Cherokee County } I over thousand eight hundred and fifty five
personally appeared before the undersigned justice of the peace within
and for the County and State of said Franklin F. Milsted aged about
forty six years a resident of said State and County who being
sworn according to law declares that he is the identical
Franklin F. Milsted who was a private in the Company com-
manded by Captain Patrick in the Regiment of
Alabama Volunteers commanded by Colonel McWilliam
in the war ^{with} the Creek Indians for the term of
three months and continued in actual service in said
war fourteen days - and was honorably dis-
charged - that he has heretofore made application for bounty land under the
act of 28th September 1850. and received a land warrant No
11,240 for forty acres of land which warrant he has
legally disposed of and cannot return.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtain-
ing the additional bounty land to which he may be
entitled under the act approved March 3rd 1855. He also
declares that he has not applied for nor received under
this or any other act of Congress any land warrant
except the one above mentioned
