Christopher W. Hebbe was born in Germany December 13, 1828; died at his home near Perry, Kansas, February 6, 1910, aged 81 years, 1 month, 24 days.

He came to America in 1853; was married to Miss Sophie Weisz in Wisconsin, April 8, 1855. There were born to them ten children, seven of whom are living. They came to Kansas in 1857, located in Rising Sun, where they lived a short time, and from there moved to the home where he died. He was years ago a member of the Lutheran church. Since his residence here he identified himself, when he was still well enough, with the worship of the Methodist Episcopal church.

Mr. Hebbe was greatly afflicted during a number of years. He was almost constantly at home during these years, where, with Mrs. Hebbe, who survived him, the patient evening time of life was passed. Their home is one of the old landmarks of a large community. The sympathy of a large circle of friends is sure to follow Mrs. Hebbe and family in their sorrow.

The funeral service was held at the home on Tuesday morning, February 8, 1910, Rev. D. A. Shutt in charge. The interment was in cemetery at Perry. The I. O. O. F. at Perry conducted the services at the grave.
