 hath granted Bargained Sold Released Conveyed and
 confirmed unto the said Thomas Shrivener his Heirs and
 assigns all that Tract or parcel of Land containing
 two hundred Acres less or more lying and being in the
 County above mentioned lying on the waters of Little
 River bounding as following Beginning at a Hickory on
 John Gilberts line from thence running South 85. W. 20.

 unto the said Thomas Shrivener his Heirs and assigns to
 and for their own proper use (and behoof) forever in
