We have been doing very well with our new set up. I have not been able to travel like I expected to. Hardly able to get machines to fill the orders that we can get or that comes to us, to say nothing about machines to carry out and demonstrate. We hape the situation will soon be in better shape and we will be able to get all the stock that we can use. Believe we will be able to make a good living out of it.

Under this new set up I can get off most any time and will look for you to come down with Bernice on his next trip. Be sure and let me know a day or two before hand so I can be here and not out on the road. Will try it real hard and see if we can catch a few. I have not wet a hook now since Clarence was down here in 1933. You might get AU to come along with you. I hear he is guite fond of fishing.

We are getting along wery well physically, except myself. Had to see the doctor this morning and am just taking it easy for the balance of this week. Hope this finds you and yours in good health, and will hear from you again real soon. All join me in sending love to all
