premises unto the said William Rankin his heirs and assigns against myself my
heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of
March one thousand eight hundred and eight and thirty second year of the
independence of the United States of America
