

With the exception of highlighting, transcription of these estate accounts records are as true to the original as it was possible to do. The penmanship of Thomas Johnston wasn't difficult per se; but, he used a finely sharpened quill pen and wrote in a tiny penmanship - except when signing his own name. Some names were especially difficult to decipher - George Forbes/Foster and Michael Bisoner/Risoner are only two examples. I urge those searching for particular names to think creatively. I apologize for my errors.
