two Sisters, namely Elizer B. Rankin and Martha A.
Rankin, to use or dispose of as they may desire having an
Equal interest in the same, provided however in case
either of them should die before I, do then I give and
bequeath the entire amount of my Estate, both Real, and
Personal unto the surviving Sister to dispose of as she
may deem proper.

to carry out this my last will and Testament
