It is alloged that a negro paraed Robert Robinson Infleted the wound upon the deceased. An Inquest was held upon the dead body of Wright, under E. J. Pinson, Esq., Trial Justice and decling as Coroner, and a verdict was rendered in accordance with the facts already stated. Robinson made his secaps, and remained at large until Tuesday morning, when he was arrested, brought to Anderson, and committed to Jall.
