perfect memorye Do constittue and appoint this to be my last  
will and Testement honestly utterly disarrulling all other wills  
heretofore made first I Recommend my soul to god and  
my body to the Earth to be Interred in decent order as  
Cacognath a Christian at the Discretion of my Executors I am  
I give and Bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha Rankin  
the one third of the Plantation while she remaines unmarried  
and if she marries the said third is to be for my son Thomas  
Rankin as his part of the Plantation also I give and  
Bequeath to my beloved wife althidio part of all the moveables  
I now possee also I give to said Bequeath unto my son thos.  
Childs part of all the moveables I now Enjoy likewise to  
my son William the middle third of the Plantation as also  
Childs part of all the moveables I now possee Also to my  
son John the lower third of the Plantation together with a  
Childs part of the moveables also to my son James a child  
part of all the moveables and Twenty Brinds

Likewise to my son Robert a childre part of the moveable  
and Inverity Bounds in money and to my Daughter  
Jane a childre part of the qmoveables and Ten Pounds in  
money also to my Daughter Mary a childre part of the  
moveables of five pounds in money as also five pounds  
more to be divided Equallyly of the parts left by me to my Sons  
William and John as the Executors shall think fit  
Also I appoinid that the Plantation with proper  
Instruments for tillage be undivided till the third even  
is of age and the Benefit the Place to before the use of the  
family and Education of the younger children and if  
of the three older Sons should die before they are of  
age their Estate to be Equallyy Divided twixt the  
two younger to will James and Robert  
Also I do Constitute and Appoint Samuel Henderson  
and Thomas Patterson my sole Executors of this my  
last will and Testament given under my hand  
and seal this twenty eighth day of January 1760

This last will and Testament of George Rankin  
died was proved by the Oaths of the witnesses thereto

motion of Samuel Henderson of Thomas Patterson  
Executors herein named who made oath according  
to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a  
Probate thereof in due form of law they having with  
James Craig and William Preston their securities  
ordered into and acknowledged their Bond according  
to law
